Preamble:

The Russian-Ukrainian war constitutes an important event in the history of international politics, due to the serious repercussions that this war had on the international system and its sub-systems. The African Sahel region is one of the regions most affected by the repercussions of this war, especially on the humanitarian, economic, geopolitical levels.

Given the strategic and economic value of the African Sahel region, it is expected that the region will turn into a target for international competition and polarization, especially in light of the repercussions of the Russian-Ukrainian war and the competition of major industrial powers to find an alternative to Russian gas and oil, which Russia uses as a strategic weapon in managing its conflicts against the West.

Many studies indicate that the African Sahel is one of the regions likely to witness crises at the level of food security, and at the level of political and security stability, especially in light of the penetration of mercenaries and private military companies (Wagner), as well as a result of the emergence of new international actors in exchange for the decline and retreat of the influence of traditional powers. Therefore, these geopolitical changes and fluctuations will have serious repercussions on the African Sahel region.

Problematic:

This forum attempts to address a problematic that: What are the repercussions of the Russian-Ukrainian war on the African Sahel region?

Importance:

The topic of the forum is of great importance as it deals with research and analysis of a structural event in international politics, especially since the Russian-

Ukrainian war threatens to bring about important structural changes in the international system, and this war will have repercussions on many regions of the world, especially the Sahel region. - *Proposing alternatives that the African Sahel countries can rely on to confront the repercussions resulting from the Russian-Ukrainian war.

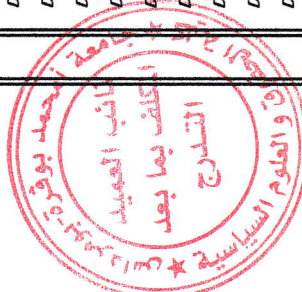
Principal Axes:
